Labor refuses to rule out bin tax increase

In Question Time in Parliament today, Labor's Environment Minister, Lily D'Ambrosio refused to rule out increasing Victoria's bin tax to pay for Labor's budget black hole.

Last week the State Treasurer announced that the Andrews Labor Government will be imposing \$4 billion of cuts on Victorians and refused to rule out new, or increased taxes.
